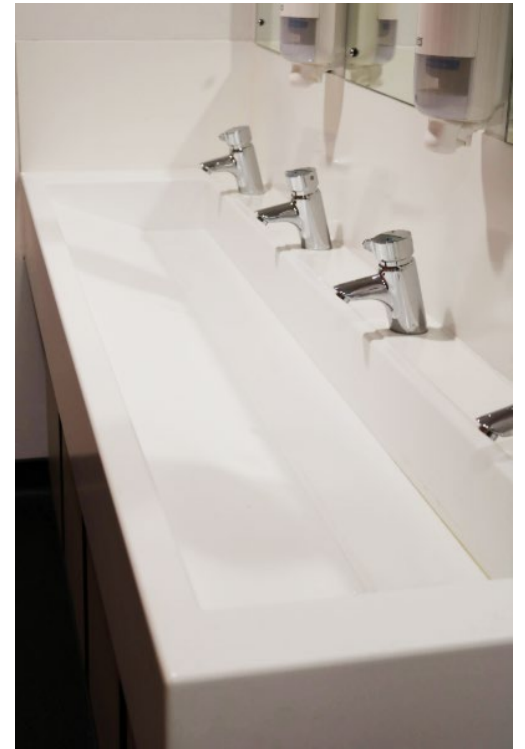


Cobham Free School Willmott Dixon | Surrey

Cobham Free School was established in 2012, with just a one form entry infant department and has now grown and developed into an all through school for pupils aged from 4-18 years old.



Brief: The school needed washrooms that would be welcoming to students in an open-plan setting, requiring cubicles that offered privacy for the pupils.
