Tring Schools is a £30 million project set to be one of the most sustainable school in the country. The new facilities include state of the art laboratories, design and technology facilities, and a learning resource centre.



Brief: Tring School required washrooms that offered maximum privacy for students while fitting seamlessly into an open-plan washroom layout. The design needed to balance openness with individual privacy, ensuring a comfortable and secure environment for all students.

Solution: The Splash cubicles with over panels, supplied by TBS Amwell, were the perfect option for Tring School. They provided the necessary privacy for students and seamlessly suited the open-plan washroom layout. The cubicles were complemented by PDQ Panel & Frame system.

Splash cubicles:

- Privacy strips and 5 mm gaps between the doors and pilasters ensure optimal privacy.
- Made of Solid Grade Laminate, a robust, water and vandal-resistant material, these cubicles are built to withstand the test of time.

PDQ Panel & Frame:

- Arriving on site pre-assembled for effortless installation, it cuts down on labour time and costs by 50% when compared to a conventional timber frame approach.
- Various panel splits available to suit WCs, urinals and WHBs.
- Complementing Solid Grade Laminate for uniformity throughout the washroom
